Sub :- Guidelines with reference to the Anti-Ragging Measures .

Ref :- HMB(B)- 20/2003 Dated 23/09/2015

Sir,


In compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009 University of Kerela -Vs- Council Principals, Colleges, Kerela and others following recommendations made by Raghawan Committee are adopted in form of Anti Ragging Guidelines to deal with menace of ragging.

- 1) Representative of Police administration should be part of the Anti Ragging Committee at the institution level and they should assist the Anti ragging committee to deal with menace of Ragging.
- 2) That Superintendent of Police/ SsP of the District should be member of District level Anti Ragging Committee and accordingly he should assist the District Anti Ragging Committee at District level.
- 3) All matters impinging in law and order, breach of peace on public tranquility should be dealt with under the penal laws of the land.
- 4) All private commercially managed lodges or hostels outside campuses must be registered with the local police authorities and permission to start such hostels or register them must necessarily be recommended by he Heads of Educational Institutions. It must be mandatory for both local police/local administration as well as institutional authorities to ensure vigil on incidents that may come within the definition of ragging.
- 5) The Supdt. of police should be web-linked so as to be in the public domain for the media and citizens to access any distress message relating to ragging .
- 6) Security guards should be sensitized towards ills of ragging and prevention thereof regularly.
- 7) A provision shall be made in the service rule for issuing certificates of appreciation to such member of staff who report ragging which will form part of their service record.

- 8) That the SHO/SP within whose jurisdictions a particular college falls shall be responsible for ensuring that no ragging takes place on the campus of the concerned college and to effectively deal with incidents of ragging, should, any such incidents take place. Once a central data base/crisis hotline is made operative then as soon as SHO/SP, within whose jurisdictions a particular college falls, is contacted by the crises hot line staff, then such SHO/SP shall deal effectively with the incident and co-operate and communicate with the crises hot line staff and/ or the independent monitoring agency. This will build confidence and encourage people to report incident of ragging without fear and delay.


These guidelines should be followed strictly to ensure compliance of the same .
