This is for general information to all selected candidates for the post of Constable (Civil Police/AAPBN) under CSLE-2025, who have successfully completed their medical examination. The Basic Training Course for the new batch will commence at the **Police Training Centre (PTC), Banderdewa** with effect from **01/05/2026 (Friday), Forenoon (FN)**

All appointed candidates are hereby directed to download their Appointment order (**Annexure-I**) from the official website i.e www.arunpol.nic.in

Failure to comply with the instructions mentioned herein may lead to cancellation of candidature.

IMPORTANT JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Reporting Details

- **Date:** 01/05/2026 (Friday)
- **Time:** 0900 hrs to 1200 hrs
- **Venue:** Police Training Centre (PTC), Banderdewa
- Only selected candidates will be permitted to report.

2. Entry & Movement Regulations

- Entry shall be strictly through **Gate No. 1** of PTC only.
- No visitors or relatives shall be permitted inside the campus under any circumstances.
- Bringing private/personal vehicles into the campus is strictly prohibited.
- Trainees shall not leave the campus without prior written permission from the competent authority.

3. Mandatory Documents at the Time of Reporting

Candidates must produce the following:

- Appointment order
- Valid ID Proof viz., Adhaar Card, Admit Card & Pan Card
- Two recent passport-size photographs
- Blood Group Report

Failure to produce any of the above documents may result in denial of entry/joining.

4. Bank Account Requirement

All trainees must have an active **Savings Bank Account** in **State Bank of India (SBI)** with an ATM card prior to reporting. This is mandatory for administrative and financial purposes.

5. Joining Deadline

No candidate shall be allowed to join after the **Zero Week (01/05/2026 to 08/05/2026)** under any circumstances, except in exceptional cases with prior approval from PHQ, Itanagar.

6. Essential Items to be Brought

- Bedding materials
- White bed sheets – 02 Nos
- White pillow covers – 02 Nos
- Mosquito net – 01 No
- Mess Security Deposit – ₹5,000/-

7. Uniform Guidelines

- Uniform items shall be issued exclusively through **Kendriya Police Kalyan Bhandar (KPKB), PTC Banderdewa** to maintain uniformity and quality.
- Trainees are strictly instructed **not to procure or bring uniforms from outside sources.**
- Required items will be made available at subsidized rates during the Zero Week.

8. Discipline & Conduct

- Strict discipline, punctuality, and adherence to institutional norms shall be maintained at all times.

- No leave shall be granted during the training period except in genuine emergencies, subject to prior approval from PHQ.
- Entry into non-designated or restricted areas is strictly prohibited.
- No out-pass shall be granted without prior approval of the **Principal, PTC**.

9. Mobile Phone & Social Media Policy

- Use or possession of mobile phones during the entire training period is strictly prohibited.
- Use of any electronic gadgets capable of communication or recording is also prohibited.
- Sharing of training-related content, photographs, or videos on any social media platform is strictly forbidden.
- Any violation shall invite **strict disciplinary and legal action**.

10. Prohibited Substances

- Possession or consumption of **tobacco, alcohol, or any contraband substances** is strictly prohibited within the campus.
- Violations will attract strict action under relevant laws, including the **NDPS Act**, and may lead to dismissal from training.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENT

Character & Antecedent Verification

- Submission of a duly filled **Character & Antecedent Verification Form** on the day of reporting is compulsory.
- No candidate shall be allowed entry into barracks or hostel accommodation without submission of the form.
- Candidates must ensure that all information furnished is **true, complete, and verifiable**. Any false declaration will lead to **immediate disqualification and legal action**.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- The Principal, PTC Banderdewa, shall ensure strict enforcement of all rules and maintain discipline at all times.
- The entire training programme shall function under the supervision of the **Inspector General of Police (Training)**, PHQ, Itanagar

All selected candidates are hereby directed to **strictly adhere to the above instructions without exception**. Non-compliance with any of the guidelines shall be viewed seriously and may result in cancellation of candidature or removal from training.
